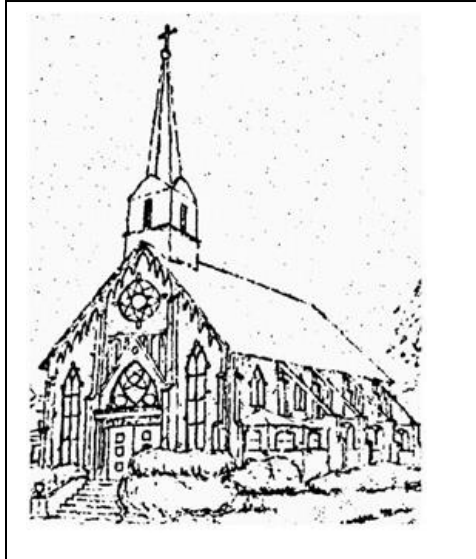

#### **Catechism of the Catholic Church – Holy Family cycle C**

534 The *finding of Jesus in the temple* is the only event that breaks the silence of the Gospels about the hidden years of Jesus.<sup>226</sup> Here Jesus lets us catch a glimpse of the mystery of his total consecration to a mission that flows from his divine sonship: "Did you not know that I must be about my Father's work?"<sup>227</sup> Mary and Joseph did not understand these words, but they accepted them in faith. Mary "kept all these things in her heart" during the years Jesus remained hidden in the silence of an ordinary life.

#### **Circles**

Thank you to everyone who sent their phone numbers to Connie for the funeral phone tree. We had 22 volunteers for the circles and if there are two more volunteers, we will be complete. The 2019 circles co-chair are posted on the back-bulletin board. When a parish member dies a phone message with funeral information will go out to all who turned in their phone numbers. Any parishioner who can donate food for the funeral is asked to drop food off at the hall any time after 6:30. Any parishioner who is able to help at the funeral is asked to text their ability to help to the number of the co-chairs for that month. The memo on the funeral will provide the numbers for that month. If there is not enough volunteer help for any funeral then the co-chair will begin calling people. We realize everyone cannot help every time but if we all help a few times there will be plenty of food and help.

A co-chair meeting will be held in the hall, in January, to go over funeral meal procedures.
