



Catechism of the Catholic Church – 3rd Sunday in OT cycle C

1695 "Justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God,"¹³ "sanctified . . . [and] called to be saints,"¹⁴ Christians have become the temple of the *Holy Spirit*.¹⁵ This "Spirit of the Son" teaches them to pray to the Father¹⁶ and, having become their life, prompts them to act so as to bear "the fruit of the Spirit"¹⁷ by charity in action. Healing the wounds of sin, the Holy Spirit renews us interiorly through a spiritual transformation.¹⁸ He enlightens and strengthens us to live as "children of light" through "all that is good and right and true."¹⁹

Parish Building Improvements

Recent improvements made in the last few months include: new toilets in the 3 main buildings; new floor in the church bathroom (water damaged); new floor in the rectory 1st floor bathroom (water damage); new carpet in the main room of the annex office building; new sacristy sink in the church (repaired leaking drain); 3 new major appliances in the rectory. All these improvements were reviewed prior by the trustees and approved. All were needed, replacing old or damaged equipment and materials.

New kitchen cabinets and countertops in the rectory; the old were all in bad shape. A big thank you to Scott Wright for helping out last week; also had a family relative help out one day. The cost was around \$3500, all material except for a contractor who helped for a few hours.

In the immediate near future, the framing and latches for the front church doors will be repaired. Later this spring, we are looking at new siding for the rectory, as well as siding and a new roof for the annex office building. Both are needed and long overdue.

The approximate costs for these updates: toilets (\$2500); church bathroom (\$1000); church sacristy (\$850); rectory appliances (\$2100); rectory bathroom (\$850); church front doors (\$450 estimate); annex carpet (\$1000).

The recent memorial gift from the Taets was used for these improvements, as well as Improvement Fund donations. Thank you to all who have helped keep up our improvement fund.
